SLUDGE•B•GONE reduces fuel costs by dissolving sludge and rust in No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and bunker fuel oil tanks. Contains a special water dispersant to eliminate and prevent troublesome sludge by imparting a uniform consistency to fuel oils. Prevents ice freeze-ups by eliminating condensate water.

If used regularly, **SLUDGE•B•GONE** helps prevent clogging of strainers and nozzles. Clears fuel lines and prevents leaks by fighting corrosion. Reduces soot by increasing burner efficiency. Use one quart (.95L) of **SLUDGE•B•GONE** Fuel Oil Additive for a 275 gallon (1040L) tank, two quarts in a 550 gallon (2080L) tank, and one gallon (3.75L) per 1,000 gallon (3785L) capacity of fuel oil.

Agitation provides the best results. Treat by adding **SLUDGE•B•GONE** at the beginning of each heating season immediately before delivery of oil.



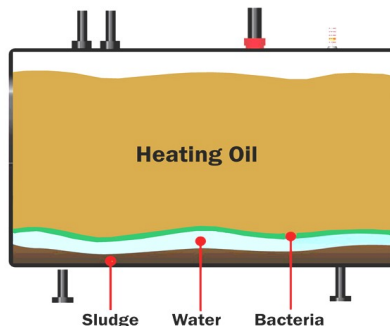

Tank contamination known as diesel sludge is an algae-like substance in which cells adhere to each other on the tank surface or at the fuel water interface. The sludge settles to the bottom of a fuel tank and can clog filters. **SLUDGE•B•GONE** dissipates the water, clears bacteria, and breaks up the sludge into smaller particles which can pass through filters and nozzles without plugging or doing damage.
